

## Moving-Out Cleaning Check List

- ✓ Remove any shelf paper in kitchen and bath cabinets you may have used.
- ✓ Wash and wipe cabinets, inside and out. A diluted solution of *Murphy's Oil Soap* works best.
- ✓ Clean oven, broiler and stove burners; lift cook top and clean underneath.
- ✓ Clean fan and vent hood above stove
- ✓ Clean and defrost refrigerator. Move out refrigerator and clean floor and sides of refrigerator.
- ✓ Kitchen and bathroom floor should be cleaned and mopped.
- ✓ All marks on walls should be touched up or washed (Mr. Clean Magic Eraser works best). All nails and tacks removed. **DO NOT** attempt to patch nail holes in walls.
- ✓ All carpets should be thoroughly vacuumed and free of spots.
- ✓ Bathroom sink, shower, tub, toilet must be clean. Please use non-abrasive cleaners on fiberglass shower and tub!
- ✓ Windows should be washed inside.
- ✓ Garbage area should be clean and free of garbage. If there is still refuse in the garbage can, please put a city refuse sticker on the can.
- ✓ Blinds should be vacuumed and free of dust.
- ✓ Vacuum and/or wipe down baseboards and window sills.
- ✓ There must be a light bulb (matching type and wattage of original) in every socket.
